## Raga of the Month-June, 2015

Malavi(PoorviThata).

Raga Malavi of PoorviThata is a rare, though melodious, Raga sharing the same scale with Poorvi, PooriaDhanashri, Shree and Gauri, but having a different melody structure. The Raga is an old Raga, but, is rarely presented in concerts; perhaps, artists prefer comparatively known Ragas, such as, PooriaDhanashri and Shree. It may be mentioned that Raga Malavi of Marwa Thata is also sometimes presented and is listed separately on the website (audio sample of Pandit Ratnakar Pai is included).

The basics of Raga Malavi(PoorviThata) can be explained as follows:

Scale- SrGmPdN; Vadi r, Samvadi P; Shadawa/Sampoorna, Time 4 p m to 7 p m;

Aroha- SrGP, GmdS"; Avaroha- S" NP, mG, rG, rS;

Chalan- S, 'NrS, SrGP, mdP, mG, mdS", mdNR" S", Nr"G"r"S", r" NdP, mdP, PGrS, 'NrS.

Important Phrases- 'NrS, SrGP, PGrS, mdP, GmdS", S"NP, mGrS, mdNr", r" NdP, Nr"G";

Phrases to be avoided- rGmP, PdNS", S" NdP (Poorvi);

rmP, mPNS" (Shree);

Sr 'N, SrGrS 'N (Gouri of PoorviThata)
