## Raga of the Month- October, 2012.

## Dhanyadhaivat (Thata Marwa, Melakarta No. 17 Suryakantha)

Raga Dhanyadhaivat (or Shuddha Dhaivat Bibhas) is a Raga from Bibhas family. Like Bibhas it is pentatonic, but Dhaivat is Shuddha -D- unlike Komal Dhaivat —d- in Raga Bibhas. Raga Dhanyadhaivat is a JodRaga- it is Bibhas in Poorvanga and Deshkar in Uttaranga. Thus, its scale consists of S,r,G,Pand D. The Raga is also considered as a morning JAWAB or counterpart of Raga Jait as both the Ragas share the same scale- however, Jait being an evening Raga, Poorvanga i.e. Bibhas anga is more prominent. In Raga Dhanyadhaivat, uttaranga i,.e Latter half,.Deshkar anga is more prominent. Shuddha Dhaivat —D- and Komal Rishabh —r- are considered as Vadi and Samvadi swaras. Raga Deshkar (PoorviThat) is similar to Raga Dhanyadhaivat except that a slight use of Shuddha Nishad is noticed sparingly.

This Raga has been documented by Pt. J.D.Patki of Wardha, Maharashtra. From "Raga Pravaham" we notice that there is a similar Raga in Suryakanta Melakarta No. 17; Raga Varnarupini which shares the same scale.
